





History Milestones

- 1922 Nurses' training funded with Sheppard Towner Act
- 1936, 13 states work with state medical societies to conduct courses
- 1939, 39 states conduct courses for OB, pediatricians, nurses, social workers and physical therapists at medical centers

History Milestones

- 1947 MCH in 4 Schools of Public Health
- 1950s, States take lead in developing training programs to educate their staff
- 1965, Interdisciplinary training for children with disabilities, Adolescent Health Seminars
- 1968 Developmental Behavioral Pediatrics
- 2007 MCH Pipeline Programs
